star and Tesla open e-filling station: only 30 minutes of loading for 270 kilometres of driving enjoyment

Alternative car propulsion systems on the rise: Two filling stations of the company star are now to be fitted out by Tesla with the world's fastest charging stations.

Elmshorn, 2 July 2015 – To start out the second half of the year, star petrol stations are partnering up with US electric car manufacturer Tesla. Two star filling stations customers will offer fast-charging Tesla stations available, known as the "Supercharger", able to recharge the Tesla Model S in just half an hour – for free – which can then drive up to some 270 kilometres.

Two star filling stations are currently being outfitted with Superchargers, the world's fastest charging ports, for up to four cars — one at Grimmen in Mecklenburg-Vorpommern and one in Uckerfelde in Brandenburg, near the Polish border. Both stations are just off the motorway, open 24 hours and have a spacious, inviting star Café where it is pleasant to spend the charging wait having a coffee and a tasty snack while browsing the attractively priced star-brand products. A mere 30-minute charge powers up the zero-emissions Tesla S sports car for a range of 270 kilometres; 40 minutes is enough to reach 80% battery capacity, which is enough to travel the international Supercharger network. The two star Supercharger stations represent an expansion of Tesla's planned Europe-wide network of charging stations strategically spaced approximately every 200 km.

"The partnership with Tesla expands star's offering of alternative mobility solutions, making an important contribution to resource conservation," said star managing director and spokesman Wieslaw Milkiewicz. But star has other such activities underway as well, selling alternative fuels and car products at several petrol stations already, like LPG and AdBlue in



Grimmen and Uckerfelde. Since October of last year star has been offering car sharing as well. Motorists in the Hamburg area can pick up and drive a vehicle at 19 different stations as part of "Share-a-Starcar".
